To submit the required information, go to https://uisides.org/. To log in, select your state, then enter your Federal Employer Identification Number (without the hyphen), State Employer Identification Number (10-digit Tax/SUTA account number), and SIDES ID Number/Access Code (same as your UIConnect Password).

In accordance with the Nebraska Administrative Code Title 221, Chapter 3, 004, A(3), you have 10 calendar days to provide employee separation information. Failure to respond on time may result in charging to your employer experience account and your appeal rights being denied.
